

General Information

NOTE: *At least one representative from each family is required to be present for Orientation Thursday, August 4th.*

OPEN HOUSE/CLASS ASSIGNMENT DAY:

A special evening has been planned for Thursday, August 4 at 3:00pm for families with last names from A-K and 7:00pm for families with last names from L-Z. This time has been set aside to give an opportunity for parents and students to come by the school to meet their teachers in their classrooms. Meeting begins in the gym.

FIRST DAY:

Killian Hill Christian School will have several teacher escorts inside the buildings to give directions. Before leaving a new student, please be sure that the student is with a teacher or someone serving as an escort in the building.

KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION:

KINDERGARTEN CLASSES WILL BE HELD THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL AND ALL KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS WILL BE DISMISSED AT 12:30 P.M. THE FIRST DAY ONLY.

HIGH SCHOOL FIRST DAY ORIENTATION:

High school students will meet on Monday morning, **August 8** (the first day of school) in an assembly to learn of details concerning their daily routines.

NOTICE:

School will be dismissed at 3:00pm for the elementary and 3:10pm for the high school. Consult the carpool section of this information packet for details concerning route dismissals.

DRESS AND HAIR CODES:

Please be aware that students are expected to comply with school dress and hair codes the first day of classes. Please consult your Parent-Student Handbook for these details.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORMS:

High School — High school students will need to wear school uniforms to physical education class. These uniforms can be purchased by each student during Orientation on Thursday, August 4, and at lunchtime throughout the school year. The girls' uniform will consist of modest, knee-length shorts, or sweat pants and the traditional school physical education shirt. The boys' uniform will consist of a T-shirt and blue gym shorts. The uniforms for both boys and girls are to be purchased from the school.

Elementary — Boys and girls in 1st and 2nd grades may wear regular school clothes to physical education class but will need tennis shoes. Girls and boys in grades 3-6 will need to purchase a school-issued physical education uniform, which will consist of shorts or sweat pants and a school T-shirt. School-issued gym clothes may be purchased at a modest cost in the lunchroom during Orientation on **Thursday, August 4**, or during lunchtime the first week of school year.

LUNCHROOM:

Lunchroom facilities are available on campus and a variety of options are available to the students for lunch including sack lunches from home, individual size microwavable meals (microwave equipment available for student use), in addition to lunch items available for purchase through the campus lunchroom.

TRAFFIC PATTERN:

Please observe our traffic pattern. This will enable us to unload students arriving in carpools and private cars much more quickly and safely. A map is enclosed showing the flow of traffic. The flow of traffic is broken down into different routes. Your route assignment is located on the carpool route instruction sheet. We ask that each driver know their route assignment and always be prompt.

CARPOOLS:

School will be dismissed at 3:00 (Elementary) and 3:10 (Jr/Sr High). For the first two weeks of school, we are requiring that carpool names that begin with the letters A-L arrive between 3:05-3:15pm and all remaining carpools arrive after 3:20pm.

Each vehicle transporting children from school is considered a “carpool.” The carpool information card enclosed must be completed for each carpool group and returned to your child’s teacher during the Orientation on **Thursday, August 5**, these cards are required to help organize carpools for the first day of school.

A map locating all school family residences is available in the hallway of the building “B” to assist in forming carpools.

PURCHASING OF LUNCH BOXES, TEE-SHIRTS, NOTEBOOKS, ETC.:

In keeping with the school’s priority of making Christ preeminent and not wanting to promote those things which would be anti-Christian or anti-American, please do not allow your child to bring the above mentioned items, or similar items, to school which picture rock groups, movie or T.V. stars, or questionable material which may be offensive to others. The final judgment as to the offensiveness of any item will be left to the school. Our desire would be that everyone would practice the principle of deference in these matters.
